

ALBERT FRANCO

October 1, 1983 - January 1, 2021

Albert "Andrew" Franco, son of Sylvia Torrez and Michael Franco, has passed away on the 1st of January, 2021 in his hometown of Barstow, California. He was 37. Andrew spent his life being a devoted father, loving husband, a dependable son and brother, but most of all, he was known for his kindness and sense of humor; leaving a lasting impression on everyone he met.

Andrew preferred to live a simplistic, but full and joyful life despite having Renal Disease (ESRD) and other numerous medical issues that he battled with daily. Through these circumstances he was able to dive deeper within his own thought process and get to know what he referred to as his true inner-self, giving him the added strength to find joy and love in even the worst of days. He believed in truth and freedom of Will over any medical diagnosis he was given; putting mind over matter and defying medical expectations.

He enjoyed working on cars, being outdoors, going on spontaneous road trips where he would shout, "Adventure!", with his family as everyone buckled in. He also loved talking in movie quotes, the number 13, playfully arguing with anyone he could challenge (he should have been a lawyer), and singing the entire soundtrack to the film, *The Nightmare Before Christmas*- at random. Andrew always thought of himself as "Family Size" and even got it tattooed on his arm by his wife.

He received his formal education from Universal Technical Institute, where he obtained professional degrees as a Ford Master Technician and mechanical engineer. He went on to be a machinist for 7 years at Vista Metals Corp., a job he loved. On his breaks he would sneak scrap metal and design little figures that he would bring home and gift to fellow patients and nurses at dialysis.

Andrew is survived by his wife, Amber Franco; daughter, Alexa Franco (mother, Rosanna Chavez); mother, Sylvia Torrez; brothers, Orlando Lobato, Dominique (Liz) Winston, John Lucero, and Michael Franco; sisters, Venessa Griego-Lobato and Amy Gonzales; as well as many nieces, nephews and cousins. He is joining his father, Michael Franco; grandparents Trinidad & Ernestina Franco and Agustin & Leonor Torrez.

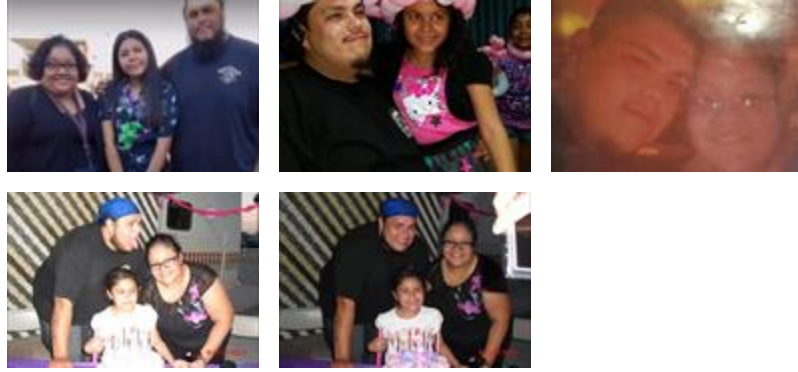


“ *My heart hurts, not for me, but for our babygirl!

Anytime he would have a health scare he would text or call me to let me know he loves me and to watch over our babygirl. I would always respond to him that he will be alright like he always is. Even with this last procedure he still called to let me know. He made it through it like i knew he would but a week or two later his heart just stopped. They couldnt get him back this time and so an hour after midnight on new years, i got the news. I knew in my heart that this was the call that I've been fearing. Telling our babygirl was one of the hardest things I would ever have to do in my life. Especially because all three of us had just spoken a few hours before in a video call and he didn't seem any different. He always knew this day would come but he always prayed that he could make it till she turned 18 or if possible to be able to walk her down the isle one day. He sure did try to stick around.. His body was worn out and God had other plans. No more suffering, no more painful procedures. Now its time to rest and be pain free. Watch over our babygirl. She misses you tremendously.

Right now its hard to know how I will go on raising her without you but i know i will figure it out and I know you will be there when it gets hard. I cant believe you are gone. You were one of a kind. Our babygirl misses you so much and so do I. I may not have been the love of your life but you still made sure I was ok. I love you Andrew!
